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The LOTUS education program is made up of a number of very talented and skilled people who have experienced mental illness first hand (also known as Mental Health Consumers). These 'consumers' are available to provide a number of services where lived experience of mental illness is acknowledged and required.




The Lotus education program charges set fees which are based on industry standards, and take into account the service being offered and the experience of the person delivering that service.

The majority of the fee is passed on to the person providing the service, with a small portion being retained by the Lotus Program to ensure the sustainability of the program.


All of our 'consumers' are trained and supported to ensure that the service you receive is of the highest quality.

This also ensures our people are equipped with the best skills and supports.


We currently have consumers available to provide the following -




**PUBLIC SPEAKING** on a number of topics relating to living with Mental Illness, including KEYNOTE addresses.



**TRAINING** in Strengths Based approaches to Mental Health, and Crisis Intervention training for 'first responders'.
